WHY HIGH ADVENTURE



As youth get older they want greater freedom, increased responsibility, and added adventure from their summer camp experience. To become their best selves, young men and women need to occasionally escape life's noise, leaving behind television, mp3 players and cell phones.

High adventure programs provide the framework for youth to grow. High adventure takes them away from the items to which they are accustomed and puts them in challenging situations that allow them to develop self-confidence, self-reliance, interpersonal skills, and gain greater spiritual self-awareness.

An active high adventure program keeps youth interested and involved. This also allows them to continue to interact with leaders whose influence will continue with them long after they move on from the Scouting unit.

PARTICIPATION DETAILS

- ◆ Boy Scouts and Venturers must be at least 13 years old or have completed the eighth grade.
- ◆ Individuals participating in aquatic activities (Sea Kayaking, Scuba and Canoeing) must successfully complete the BSA Swim test.
- ◆ Registration is open to entire troops, crews or individuals.
- ◆ Fees include all special equipment, staff support, transportation, and food. You can't beat this price or the experience. Visit our website for updated program fees.
- ◆ A trained staff member accompanies all programs, teaching new skills and customizing the trip to suit the needs and desires of every participant.

TREK PROGRAMS



APOSTLE ISLANDS SEA KAYAKING:

This program will find you paddling along the Apostle Islands National Lakeshore in Lake Superior! Participants spend 5 days on the water and 4 nights on islands. Your trek will begin with an orientation to kayaking skills and include tours of the spectacular sea caves.



ISLE ROYALE BACKPACKING:

Isle Royale's secluded backcountry offers ideal terrain for hikers. Participants spend 5 days backpacking the island and taking in the beauty.

CRYSTAL LAKE SCUBA ADVENTURE:

Scuba Trek is a PADI Open Water Diver course where participants experience the excitement and adventure of our underwater world. This adventure begins with classroom Scuba instruction and continues with several dives in Crystal Lake at Tesomas Scout Camp in Rhinelander.




BOUNDARY WATERS CANOEING:

In partnership with Northern Tier, this program will find you paddling in the Boundary Waters Canoe Area Wilderness. Participants spend 5 days on the water before returning to camp on Friday.

NORTHWOODS EXPERIENCE:

These introductory programs are designed for Scouts that are just beginning their high adventure experiences. Programs begin with basic instruction at L.E. Phillips Scout Reservation or Tesomas Scout Camp. Tuesday - Thursday Scouts hit the trail or river for three days of fun. Visit our website for full program details.
